Dear Finals Contestants:

The ACA Finals will be held on October 9 & 10, 2026, at the White County Fair Grounds located in Searcy, Arkansas. The Grand Entry lineup will begin at 6:30 p.m. on Friday with the rodeo commencing at 7:00 p.m. On Saturday, the Grand Entry lineup will begin at 6:00 p.m. with the rodeo beginning at 6:30 p.m. All contestants are highly encouraged to participate in the Grand Entry with rough stock contestants walking in the arena. Dress Code: Standard western attire as defined in the rule book with no themes.

The timed event cattle will be on the grounds Friday October 9, 2026, and a run through at 1:00 p.m. in main arena and goats tied at 3:00 p.m. in the practice arena. There will be an open arena for all contestants on Friday, October 9, 2026, 1:30 p.m. to 3:00 p.m. The arena will be cleared at 3:00 p.m. and no access will be allowed until the Grand Entry. Check-In time for contestants starts at 1:00 p.m. at the Arena Office. As a reminder, no attire with logos or advertisement of another association will be allowed in the rodeo or the bucking chutes at any time.

Upon arrival at the finals, you will be required to provide negative coggins for each horse and for those that are traveling from out-of-the State of Arkansas, veterinary health papers will be required. In addition, horses from the State of Arkansas, please check with your vet or animal health professional for documentation requirements for in-state travel.

Contestants will not be charged to enter the fairgrounds. In addition, each contestant will have two (2) complimentary tickets at the gate when you arrive on Friday. These tickets may be used for either performance of the ACA Finals Rodeo. Tickets purchased at the gate are \$10.00 for an adult and \$5.00 for child (6-12 years old), and 5 & under are free.

On Saturday, at 1:00 p.m. the General Membership Meeting will be held at the arena. Awards and pictures will be completed for the Horse of the Year Winners. Please dress in cowboy attire for pictures. On Saturday night, awards will be throughout the rodeo and directly following the rodeo performance.

Please note there are NO tie outs for horses. If you have not purchased a stall at this time, there is a link at [acarodeo.com](http://acarodeo.com) or on our Facebook page to do so. Shavings for stalls are the responsibility of the contestant. Please do not park in a parking spot with an electrical hookup if

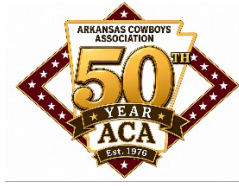

- Timed Event Contestants: Please get with the Director/Board Member of your event behind the back pens. Please enter at a continuous pace lining up on both sides of the arena.
- When exiting the arena – Please note ALL CONTESTANTS will exit through the center alley. Please be patient and safe.
- Contestants are to compete both nights of the finals. If you are injured in one event and cannot compete, you are not allowed to compete in any other events.

(7 CBR then 7 JBR then drag) (8 CBR then 8 JBR then drag)

Following each event, the round winner will circle the arena behind the flag. Please be ready in the alley.

- Judges make the final decision on barrier malfunctions.
